This is a fantastic fully guided 5 day deer hunt in southern Washington. You will be hunting vast country of private and public land with an experienced guide to see that your hunting is enjoyable and successful.

Hunting in the Rainforests of Washington to the eastern slope is unlike any other hunting challenges in the World!

The thick underbrush and steep terrain offer long life to the famous Blacktail, Muley's and

Roosevelt Elk. Growing up at the Foothills of the Cascades, predicting the habits and locations to put you in the right place at the right time is what makes us so successful on these elusive animals.

There are various techniques on how to hunt Mule Deer, Blacktail Deer, Bear and Roosevelt Elk in South Washington State using the techniques that we have mastered and have made us extremely successful. Having a good set of eyes and covering ground, while moving cautiously through the woods at a slow pace, keeping the wind to your face and being in the right area are what bring success.

Brian has been in the guiding business for 10 years and Christian has for 20 plus years. A combined almost 30 years in the business working to put you on the best animals Washington has to offer. Growing up as locals they have learned the areas and the animal patterns. Learning exactly what to look for and where is the key to finding these animals in Washington's rainforest. The cascade mountain range extends from Canada to Mexico. It is famous for the Pacific Crest Trail, and the series of volcanoes, Mount Saint Helens, Mount Adams, Mount Hood, and Mount Rainer. This is truly some of the most rewarding hunts this world has to offer.

In Washington State,

Non-Resident Deer Tags are \$ 434 include any habitat stamps or anything else required to be legal to hunt that game animal.

Non-Resident Elk Tags are \$ 434 include any habitat stamps or anything else required to be legal to hunt that game animal.

Non-Resident Elk & Deer Combo Tags are \$ 674 includes any habitat stamps or anything else required to be legal to hunt that game animal.

Non-Resident Deer, Elk & Combo Tags are \$ 794 includes any habitat stamps or anything else required to be legal to hunt that game animal.

Combo Deer-Elk Hunts are available.

With these fully guided hunt skinning and caping your animal is included. Meat processing is available locally if you wish to have it done at your own expense. You will be hunting mostly private land depending on where the game concentration is the best at the time of your hunt and our scouting has confirmed it.

There is the option to hunt archery, muzzleloader or rifle for each animal. All hunts are 5 days unless otherwise specified hunts that you arrive the day prior to the hunt and leave the day after your hunt if not before. Licenses are available over the counter so there is no drawing or expensive vouchers required to be added to the hunt. A non-hunter charge is only \$100 per day covering food and lodging. There is a minimum party size of 2 unless

approved by the outfitter. The outfitter will contact the client after the deposit is paid with detail and directions as where to meet, equipment to bring and so on. All weapons need to meet state regulations and the outfitter will help coordinate that with the clients.

You won't need a sleeping bag for the motel lodging or the wall tent hunts. A camping trailer is allowed if you would rather but the hunt price does not change to reflect it. Meals are provided on the elk and deer hunts but not the bear hunts.

If you fly into Portland, you can rent a car and drive to the hunt. If you don't need to rent one the guide will pick you up and take you back to the airport at a trip price of only \$150 per hunter.

HOW TO TRANSPORT MEAT/TROPHIES: meat will have to be taken to the butchers and worked out with the client. Trophy's can be mailed or fedX'd if needed.

Hunting Licenses & Hunter Education

Washington State allows over the counter purchasing of Licenses. Anyone born after January 1, 1972 is required to have completed a Hunter Education Course, with one exception, there is a Special One-time Hunter Education Deferral.

Special One-time Hunter Education Deferral Available

In 2007 the Washington State Legislature approved a measure that now allows a one-year, once-in-a-lifetime deferral of hunter education training. The deferral option is available to individuals who are accompanied by an experienced hunter who has held a Washington hunting license for the previous three years. A \$20 application fee is required.

General Elk Details

You will be hunting both private and public ground depending on where the elk are at the time of the hunt. We hunt population densities not acres to put you in position for a bull elk as quick and as easy as possible. Some hunters fill the first day, those trophy hunter pass a few but fill by the last day. Out success rate on this hunt is very good.

Elk Coastal Hunts

This is a 5 day motel closest to current game location. You will be picked up each morning in 4x4 trucks each morning at your motel to ride to spot then stalk elk in clear cuts. Clear cut shooting can be long so 300 yard shots are common and it is best to be comfortable at 400 with a 30.06 rifle or larger. It is not unusual to see 40-80 head of elk per day. These elk are big targets with a chest kill area of about 20"x20".

There is more hunting ground than can be covered in a day and the 4x4 truck is the best way to see as much property as possible per day. After spotting elk and glassing them for size the guide will make a stalk with you to get as close as the area vegetation allows.

You will be taken to a back woods camp with wall tents where you will hunt from during the hunt. The bull average sizes are larger but the hunt can be physically demand. You will be hiking each day down canyons and working game rick areas. This hunt is physically demanding so keep that in mind when deciding on the coastal hunt or the back woods hunt. This does not include hot showers but we make the best of it. If we get shut out of the woods due to fire danger which does happen, then we will have to set up with the closest motels. We do use horses at times for this hunt to get you back in where the bulls stay and no one else can get there.

Black Bear

Most of our Bear Hunts require lots of glassing across canyons on south-face slopes, spot & stalk, to close the gap for a good shot! We recommend a high caliber magnum rifle to put these bears on the ground; though archery is an option.

The units we hunt have about 30% color-phase bears. There are several Game Management Units that we hunt. We choose the best areas decided by our scouting efforts. Typically these hunts will entail high altitudes, where berries are prevalent and ripe!

We provide a packed lunch for each hunt, which is often consumed in the field. Most of the lodging for these hunts is motels. Hunters are responsible for their lodging costs; we can however assist with coordinating your lodging.
